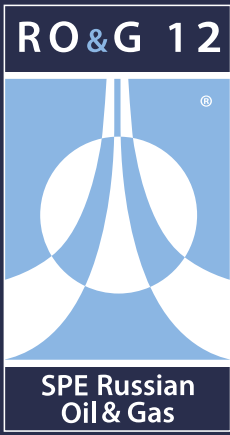

**Dear Colleagues,**

On 18-20 October 2012, Moscow will host the 4th SPE Russian Oil and Gas Exploration and Production Technical Conference and Exhibition (ROGC) - a key international scientific and technical forum in Russia on oil and gas exploration and production. Having started in 2006, this event is now well established in the industry with an exclusive conference organised by the Society of Petroleum Engineers (SPE).

Since ROGC 2010 the industry has seen an increase in the development of new oil and gas fields with complex geological structures and low reservoir quality, located in adverse climatic conditions. Exploration and development of these fields require new methods in order to tap these reserves. Today, Russian and international oil and gas producers continue to work together, integrating their knowledge and technology to ensure efficient management of domestic and global oil and gas resources.

The agenda of the Russian biannual conference traditionally consists of all major issues in the area of hydrocarbon exploration and production. This includes hydrodynamic fundamentals and petrophysics, new methods and technology for well drilling and survey, prospecting, exploration, development of oil and gas fields, as well as enhanced hydrocarbon recovery. The conference will also focus on environmental protection and safety in sophisticated

process operations. The conference aims to present: the best global practices and innovations for enhanced petroleum exploration at greater depths; drilling and increased well production; comprehensive approaches to development of oil gas and condensate fields; and improved oil and condensate recovery.

The 2012 SPE Russian Oil and Gas Programme Committee would like to invite you to submit your abstracts for the 4th SPE Russian Oil and Gas Exploration and Production Technical Conference and Exhibition. Preference will be given to papers written in compliance with SPE standards and guidelines and with clear presentation of the findings. This will allow the Programme Committee to select the most interesting and important papers, with a mix of expertise, innovation, traditions, and state-of-the-art practices.

## GUIDELINES FOR PAPER PROPOSALS

- Obtain necessary clearance from your management
- The paper proposal should be submitted by 10 February 2012 online at [www.russianoilgas.com](http://www.russianoilgas.com)
- The paper proposal must be in English or in Russian
- The paper proposal must be no more than 300 words and should include a description of the proposed paper, results/ conclusions, and the technical category most applicable to your paper
- Authors of paper proposals selected for the conference will be notified by the beginning of April 2012
- If your paper proposal is accepted, it may be published, as submitted, in conference information media, including on the event website
- Your paper proposal may be accepted for either technical presentation or poster presentation. If your paper proposal is accepted you will be required to produce a technical paper (manuscript) in both English and Russian to support your technical presentation
- The manuscript will be included on the conference Proceedings CD and will also be available on OnePetro.org
- The manuscript is to be submitted by 16 July 2012
- Failure to submit your manuscript by this deadline will result in your presentation being withdrawn from the Conference Programme and the author will not be allowed to present.
- Detailed instructions for the preparation of manuscripts, slides and posters will be sent to the corresponding author of each accepted paper.
- SPE assumes no obligation for expenses incurred by authors for travel, lodging, food, or other incidental expenses.

## RECOMMENDED ORDER OF PAPER PROPOSAL

### ■ DESCRIPTION OF THE PAPER

Outline the scope and nature of the work upon which the paper is based (e.g. field data, laboratory data, original analysis, or computer work). If the paper is a review paper, make the extent of coverage clear.

### ■ APPLICATIONS

Describe the possible applications of the knowledge provided in the paper.

### ■ RESULTS, OBSERVATIONS, AND CONCLUSIONS

Summarise the results and major conclusions to be presented in the paper and state how these differ from previous work on the same subject. State whether new information will be revealed and whether data from field, laboratory, or computer will be included.

### ■ TECHNICAL CONTRIBUTIONS

Describe the significance of the proposed paper by listing up to three technical contributions or additions to the technical knowledge base of the petroleum industry.

## COMMERCIALISM

The Society of Petroleum Engineers has a policy against the use of commercial trade names, company names or language that is commercial in tone in titles, text or slides. Use of such terms will result in careful scrutiny by the Programme Committee in evaluating paper proposals and the presence of commercialism may result in it being withdrawn from the Conference Programme.

## COPYRIGHT

All authors of papers presented at the conference will be required to complete and submit a copyright release form to the Society of Petroleum Engineers or submit the copyright exemption form where applicable.
